



Philippe François-Xavier Corvini was born in 1972 in Korea. After graduate study in Biology and Chemistry he obtained PhD in Biotechnology at ENSAIA (Nancy, France). He worked five years as postdoc at RWTH Aachen University (Germany) and was appointed as full professor and head of the Institute for Ecopreneurship at the School of Life Sciences at the University of Applied Sciences and Arts Northwestern Switzerland (FHNW).

He obtained habilitation at RWTH Aachen University and University of Basel (Switzerland). He is also adjunct professor at Nanjing University and at the Yancheng Institute of Environmental Technology and Engineering in China and Doctor Honoris Causa of Iasi University (Romania). P.F.-X.

Corvini published more than 80 papers on the metabolism of micropollutants (*ipso*-substitution reactions) and (nano)biocatalysts for natural resource valorization and wastewater treatment.

He serves currently as vice-president of the European Federation of Biotechnology (EFB) and chairs the Environmental Biotechnology section of EFB. He is member of the sub-committee Biotechnology of IUPAC and member of the board of the International Society of Environmental Biotechnology (ISEB).
